The School Board is beginning to plan for **School Year 2021-22**. This includes planning for teacher assignments based on enrollment at each grade level. We currently have 85 students enrolled and anticipate that this number will remain steady moving into next school year, however the marketing committee has been working hard to get the word out about GHES so we are hoping to increase that number! If you know that you are moving, or have plans to enroll your student somewhere else, it is important that you get that information to Mrs. Mathias as soon as you know about it. Our funding is based strictly on our enrollment, and our hiring is based on the funding we receive. It is important to us that we have accurate numbers when we are planning so we can provide the best services to students that we possibly can. Thanks, in advance, for your consideration of this.

Kindergarten Round-Up is going to happen a bit differently this year due to the pandemic. We are asking that families with children who are 5 by September 1st and are eligible to participate in kindergarten in the fall of 2021 contact Mrs. Giese (mgiese@glacialhills.org) to receive a packet and video of information about the program. They will then be able to set up a family visit that will be conducted in June. In August there will be a day where the students can come to school for the morning, prior to the first day of school, and spend the day in the classroom and become acclimated to the building. *All children who plan to enroll in kindergarten must have completed a preschool screening and have their vaccinations up to date prior to the start of school.*

Preschool registration is open for the 2021-22 school year. Please contact Mrs. Uribe (muribe@glacialhills.org) for more information. We will continue to offer a 3 year old program on T/TH mornings from 7:30-11:30 and a 4 year old program M/W/F from 7:30-3:30.

Summer School plans are in the works. Please return registration forms by Friday, April 16th. If you need another copy of the form let us know and we'll be sure to get that sent home! The dates for summer school are June 7-10 and 14-17, M-TH 8:00 - 3:00. Breakfast and lunch will be provided. Parents are responsible for the transportation.
