#### Discussion:

Academic Progress: Mrs. Poegel presented how she's changed the way she teaches some of her curriculum over the years since she started. Mr. Harrison discussed how beneficial it's been for the students in 2nd and 3rd grade to switch classrooms for Reading (to Mrs. Bittman's room) and Math (to Mr. Harrison's room). Mrs. Kriesel created a template for academic reporting for the teachers to use when presenting their updates to the Board.

Marketing update: The metal structure at the top of the hill by the highway has allowed the school to hang banners on. The GHES Facebook page is being used regularly to announce to the community things that are happening at the school

**Fundraiser update:** The teachers and students have participated in more community involved activities; They're looking into participating in Casey's (gas station) cash for classrooms - purchases done at Casey's accumulates points and the points eventually into monetary value, the purchaser can designate GHES as receiver of those points; The committee created a fundraising calendar that circulated at the beginning of the year so parents know up front what item is going to be designated for that month.
